

Street Light Update (as per VCA Newsletter dated September 30, 2020)

In November and December, 598 streetlights will be converted to decorative LED fixtures in NOTL. This will significantly reduce carbon emissions and costs.

In The Village,

- Light bulbs will be replaced to LED on streets east of Murray Street
- Although typical street light fixtures measure approximately 20 feet, here in The Village, they are only 12 feet high, which provides us with more discreet lighting
- Currently there's an issue with some lights on Macdonell Road and a portion of Brock Street with LED lights without lens/globes and the temperature of the lights - cool vs. warm
- The fixtures in that section of The Village will no longer have a lens however the Town is confident the new lights will be less intrusive while providing adequate light

Rest assured that the VCA has been in constant contact with the Town over the last few years to make sure we get the best possible solution for our community.
